Campers will learn how to control the robot to avoid obstacles, find, pick up and carry objects, and even compete in different competitions.

The advanced camp is for students who do well in the intro camp and are looking for more advanced problems. We strive to create new challenges for every camp each year. Many students who don't feel ready for the advanced camp choose to enroll in the intro camp again.

Lego® robots are easy and fun to program. The software used to program the robots was designed for grade school children so campers will be able to start right away.
