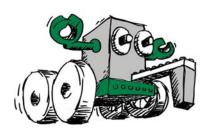
### Nancy Rice

programming tools designed to grow with him/her. The cScibot Robotic Camps will be held in various classrooms in the Computer Science Department located in Streibel Hall on the University of North Dakota campus.
