
Nancy Rice is the Department's office manager who tracks the camp finances.


Nancy Nettum is the Department's administrative assistant who handles the purchasing and "behind the scene" tasks.

Lego® robots are easy and fun to program. The software used to program the robots was designed for grade school children so campers will be able to start right away. There are several means of creating control programs to operate the robot, each with more power and complexity. As campers become more proficient at controlling their robot, there are program-

ming tools designed to grow with him/her. The cScibot Robotic Camps will be held in various classrooms in the Computer Science Department located in Streibel Hall on the University of North Dakota campus.

In the intro camp each camper will use a Lego® Mindstorm[™] NXT robot kit to build a computer controlled robot. The campers will learn to program solutions to teach the robot to react to its environment. Campers will learn how to control the robot to avoid obstacles, find, pick up and carry objects, and even compete in different competitions.

The advanced camp is for students who do well in the intro camp and are looking for more advanced problems We strive to create new challenges for every camp each year. Many students who don't feel ready for the advanced camp choose to enroll in the intro camp again. 
